- We think it is worth confirming all members of the groups continued commitment moving forwards, as we enter the next phase;
- Must all focus groups work in the same way to obtain the data they need, or which each group work differently on a horses for courses basis;
- Are we allowed to be informed of the overall budget for the delivery of the NDP; and
- Whether any of the policy topic areas could be grouped together to cover more general "themes", which would assist us with our relative strengths and areas of interest.

As a group, we can assure you of our continued commitment and are looking forward to seeing the proposals as they start to evolve.
