3. Community, and Green Infrastructure Survey

- 3.1. The Steering Group (SG) thanked everyone who completed the [Community Survey](#) and the [Green Infrastructure Survey](#): 381 and 175 respectively.
- 3.2. SG continues to promote both surveys through personal contacts, media, local businesses, schools, and other organisations.

4. Site Allocation

- 4.2. Recently, SG was informed that the WC have agreed to publicise a Call for Sites with their contacts.

5. Locality and AECOM

- 5.1. SG has successfully submitted a grant application to Locality to assist SNDP with associated costs of hiring AECOM to conduct a housing needs assessment.
- 5.2. SG also learned that Locality offers more financial resources and technical expertise should they require it.

6. Business Survey

- 6.1. SG decided to postpone business consultation events due to Covid-19. However, the Group continues to prepare to contact local business to ask their opinion regarding SNDP.

7. Waste Recycling Centre

- 7.1. SG continues to work closely with WC to address the possible relocation of the Salisbury waste recycling centre
