1.1. This report introduces a revised Tree Policy for approval.

2.1. Salisbury City Council (SCC) manages a significant number of trees in the City. This revised policy will guide our management of these trees and replaces the previous Tree Policy agreed by this committee in 2015.

 - 3.3.2. Damage caused to property from trees- the policy gives specific advice for home owners to follow para 3.30
 - 3.3.3. Management of Riverside Trees this policy shows that SCC will follow the Environment Agency advice in respect of these trees para 6.
 - 3.3.4. Ash Die back the policy shows what actions SCC will take as a council for this type of trees para 7
