1. Report Summary:

1.1. This report introduces an application for a Major Grant from the Magna Learning Partnership.

2. Background:

- 2.1. In accordance with Salisbury City Council's (SCC) [Grants Policy](#), Major Grants exceed £3,000 and are for projects and activities that sit outside Community Grants criteria. Applicants are encouraged to contact the City Clerk to discuss the application process before an application is submitted. Applicants must complete a Grant Application Form and forward it to SCC with the required supporting paperwork.
- 2.2. The Responsible Finance Officer (RFO) reviews the application against the mandatory requirements and a recommendation will be made to the City Clerk. The City Clerk, in consultation with the Leader of the Council, determines whether the application is to be progressed. Applications which are accepted will be considered at the next meeting of the Finance and Governance Committee.
- 2.3. Applicants maybe asked by the Council to attend the committee meeting at which the application will be considered to introduce their application and answer any questions from Councillors.
- 2.4. If the Committee award a grant, then the applicant will be advised they have 60 days to accept the offer and apply for the funding to be released by signing and returning the Grant Acceptance Form sent with the formal offer. Conditions may be placed on the offer which may need to be met before funds will be released.
- 2.5. The applicant will be required to complete an 'end of project/annual return' once the project is complete as shown in the policy.
- 2.6. There is no budget allocated for Mayor Grants. If such a grant is awarded, the funding will come from the Council's reserves.

3. Secret Spitfire Applications

- 3.1. The Magna Learning Partnership Major Grant Application is shown at Annex A to follow) plus a supporting letter at Annex B (Doc 83864).
- 3.2. The RFO's report against the mandatory requirements will be shown at Annex C (Doc to follow). The City Clerk and the Leadership Group of the Council, plus the Leader of the Conservative Group, have agreed that this application shall be progressed and so this committee is now asked to consider this application.
- 3.3. The applicant is asking for £5,000 to develop at 3G pitch at Sarum Academy. The total cost of the project is £725,000 and £565,000 of funding has already been raised, leaving a shortfall of £160,000.
