### 1. Report Summary:

1.1. This report seeks the views of this committee in respect of waiting restriction requests received to date.

#### 2. Background:

- 2.1. In order to manage the waiting restriction requests, a process was devolved from Wiltshire Council to engage with the Town and Parish Councils enabling them to input their local knowledge into the assessment process.
- 2.2. All requests from residents for waiting restrictions are sent directly to Parish Councils who send out a standard request form to gain as much detail as possible.
- 2.3. Requests for waiting restrictions are to be assessed by the Town and Parish Councils giving validation to the request, rank in order of priority and send to the Network Management Team each January.
- 2.4. The top ranking requests for all areas will then be assessed against the full TRO assessment matrix by the Engineers in the Network Management Team and scores reported to the Wiltshire Cabinet Member for agreement on which schemes to progress each year.
- 2.5. Full guidance is shown at Appendix A. (Doc 47939).
- 2.6. A summary of 2018 requests are shown below. The full applications were circulated to the committee Members by the Corporate Services Manager on 2 January, which showed the detail behind these applications.
