1. Report Summary:

1.1. This report introduces a report from Wessex Community Action (WCA) concerning its Salisbury City Council (SCC) grant funded activity in 2019/2020 and a grant application for 2020/2021.

- 2.1. At Services Committee on 17 Dec 2018 WCA were awarded a grant of £20,000 for 2019/2020. They had applied for a £20,000 award for 2 years but this was not granted as the Committee wished to consider the outcome of one year's grant before a longer term grant was agreed.
