#### 1. Report Summary:

1.1. This report introduces the Revenue and Capital Budget Monitoring Reports of the Council for the period 1 April 2019 to 31 December 2019 (Quarter 3).

1.2. The Budget Monitoring Reports, attached at Appendix 1 (Revenue) and Appendix 2 (Capital), summarise the financial position as at 31 December 2019.

### 2. Key Statement Features:

- 2.1. The budget monitoring reports for the first nine months of the financial year show that the Council is managing its income and expenditure within budgetary expectations and is currently underspending by £30k.
- 2.2. Reduced expenditures have resulted in a £129k underspend on budgets as at the end of quarter 3. This has materially arisen from vacancies within the Establishment, fewer repairs and maintenance across properties and general works and streets maintenance, and a reduced irrecoverable VAT liability.
- 2.3. The budget does show, however, that overall income generation has fallen with under-recovery currently at £99k. This has materially arisen from reduced revenue generated by the Crematorium and Cemeteries which have seen a fall in income commensurate with the fall in the death rate nationally, as well as a fall in markets income.
- 2.4. The revenue budget monitoring statement at **Appendix A** has been profiled, where applicable, to reflect activities which do not occur on a regular monthly basis (ie. 1/12), such as loan repayments and commercial property leases.
- 2.5. The capital budget monitoring statement at **Appendix B** has been profiled as costs are incurred; this is because funding for capital is project based.
- 2.6. The expenditure revenue position for core functions as at 31 December 2019 is:

2.7. The income revenue position for core functions as at 31 December 2019 is:

2.8. As at 31 December 2019, £461k of the £756k capital budget has been spent. Eight projects have been completed and four project budgets have been set aside for deferral to 2020/21. Capital receipts of £117k have reduced capital costs to date to £344k.
