Environmental Services Team – December 2022

Environmental Services Streetscene

- Venture - 189 reports in November with the highest categories including ASB/begging (52), and Council matters (26), which includes liaising with rough sleepers, patrolling SCC sites and events including community engagement projects and escorting staff to collect money
- Part of the service area at the Coach Station toilet block converted to a boot room for the foot patrols/barrow staff
- New electric sweeper and electric van bought in to replace diesel models
- Setting up Winter gritting arrangements - Please advise Streetscene Team if salt bins in the parish need replenishing
- Repaved most of the cracked paving on Endless St



Environmental Services Facilities

- Poultry Cross works continuing with the aim to be completed by the Spring.
- Refurbishment of Fisherton Recreation Ground toilets to commence this Winter. This is being timed to coincide with the River Park project.
- Camping & Caravan Club – Planning application to install 19 further hard standing pitches being submitted with project scheduled to commence in the New Year.
- Submitted details for Free Assessment of EV Charging Points with Joju Solar for Lush House Car Park.



Environmental Services CCTV

- We have received 23 requests to view footage in November with 14 of those seized as evidence by the police.
- All 4 Friday & Saturday nights were covered between 20:00 & 04:00 in November.
- During November, 21 different CCTV Operators manned the control room with 19 of those volunteers donating various hours of their free time.
- The total number of hours worked in the control room this November is 400.
- We will be interviewing for the CCTV Managers role on Friday 16th December.



Environmental Services Crematorium & Cemeteries

- The cremation figures from April - October total 890 compared to 915 in 2021.
- There are currently 39 services booked for December.
- A Memorial Inspection was conducted at St. John's closed Churchyard, Lower Bemerton.
- The Spoil Tips for all cemeteries are being cleared and repaired.
- We continue to receive positive feedback about The Avenue Cemetery.



Environmental Services Parks

- SCC are working alongside the Well-being walker's group to improve accessibility at Harnham Recreation ground. Work is set to take place in the coming weeks to widen the entrances to allow for improved access for mobility scooters, prams, and wheelchairs
- Work to repair and level the entrance and exit of the carpark surface at Hudson Field will be taking place in the coming weeks
- Our new Trilo leaf sucker machine has arrived
- The replacement quarter-pipe has been ordered for Churchill Gardens.
- Winter floral display baskets have been installed at the Guildhall and Market square, the planters and tubs have also been planted
