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### 1. Report Summary:

1.1. This report asks for the committee to consider one Youth Bursary Grant applications received by the Communities Team and to vote on the awarding of this grant.

### 2. Background:

- 2.1. £5,000 of the Youth Budget for 2022/23 was allocated to these pilot grants by the Community Services Committee after consideration of the Community Services Report – Youth Bursary Grants Proposal (Doc 88827).
- 2.2. £750 is the maximum available for each applicant, under the small grants provision in the SCC Grants Policy (Doc 87280).
- 2.3. Grants to the value of £2,809 were awarded by the subcommittee to SAYM, Salisbury FC, Wiltshire Creative, and Salisbury Rugby Club on the 30 Jan 2023, from a total £5,000 budget. Therefore there is £2,191 available to award.

### 4. Application Detail:

#### 4.1. Developing Health and Independence (DHI) Motiv8 Service - Charity:

- 4.1.1. DHI is a registered charity commissioned to deliver the Motiv8 Substance Misuse Service for young people (ages 11 to 19) in the Salisbury area.
- 4.1.2. This application proposes to use Bursary funds to offer Gym access to vulnerable young people supported by the service as they seek to develop positive habits and support continued wellbeing and a drug free lifestyle.
- 4.1.3. "This outlet offers young people an enjoyable and purposeful activity they would not ordinarily be in a position to fund, nor have the confidence to access, demonstrating that they can be stimulated without needing to use substances.

It can show young people a different way of life and they help young people bond with their Motiv8 keyworkers, increasing the effectiveness of future interventions.”

4.1.4. Eligibility for the gym bursary will be use of the Motiv8 service.

4.1.5. This is a novel initiative for Motiv8 that is based on feedback and exploratory work with current service users.
