Bismillah

In the name of Allah (God) most beneficent most merciful. Rabbi - shawahrli sadri - Wa yassarli - amri whalul - ookdatam- mileesani - yaff ka wahi - kawli-

You might say what was that! :) I can assure you... I haven't called anyone by anyone's name. However, at the end I will explain the meaning.

Deputy Lord Lieutenant, excellency, Lords, honourable MP, neighbouring Mayors, distinguished guest, our twinning friends, fellow Councillors, friends and family,

Let me greet you with an Islamic greeting Assalamualikum. Wa rahmatulahi wa barakatuhu: May the peace and blessings of Allah (God all mighty be upon you all.

My name is Atiqul Hoque: born in Bangladesh back in 1976! Yes! That's makes me a very young mayor with lots of grey hair.

I Came to UK at a very young ages and grew up in east London, where I went to school and college.

"History is made"

Today people of Salisbury has chosen their First British Bangladeshi Muslim Mayor! I'm delighted to be part of this tradition which stretches from 14 Centuries, when the first Mayor was made back in 1387 call John hethe..... "I almost said John Glen"

When history is made; everyone becomes part of this memorable day. In summary I think Salisbury is my home it's where my heart and soul belongs.

Salisbury is a wonderful city we have been through a lot, from the Novichok incident to the pandemic, but time has come to leave all these behind us and look forward to the future and I think it's possible because we now have a new Monarch King Charles, who I admire simply because he devoted his life for his mother and anyone who loves their mother get my absolute respect, because for me my mother is the world. Also we have a great Prime Minister another history and the good thing is he understands maths.

My Mayoral year I will focus on bringing the community together, promoting Salisbury for the benefit of everyone.

I'd liked to promote Salisbury in the best of form we have lots to shout about. Our beautiful cathedral, History and culture, strengthened our relationship with our twinned cities, Xanten , saints North Carolina, Maryland and many more.
