1. Report Summary:

1.1. This report introduces a draft policy concerning the CCTV that it operates within the city.

2. Background:

- 2.1. Salisbury City Council (SCC) in partnership with Salisbury BID has in a place a CCTV surveillance system that predominantly covers the city centre, but also includes the use of mobile cameras that can be placed in other locations across the city as required.
- 2.2. The draft policy details the purpose, use and management of the CCTV system and details the procedures to be followed in order to ensure that SCC complies with relevant legislation and codes of practice.
- 2.3. This will include SCC having due regard to the Data Protection Act 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the Protection of Freedoms Act 2012 and the Human Rights Act 1998.

3.1. SCC's operation and management of CCTV helps enable crime prevention and detection and the apprehension and prosecution of offenders, whilst maintaining the required legislation and standards as set out in the policy.
