

#### **Your Salisbury Pantry**

Did you know that much of the fresh food at the Pantry is redistributed by the major supermarkets via the Fareshare Go scheme.

Every time we accept a donation Fareshare calculates our impact. We've had over 500 collections of food that would otherwise go to waste, meaning our volunteers and members are helping to make Salisbury a greener city.

Your Local Pantry also released their impact report recently showing that the average shop at a Pantry saves a member £21. This means that those who shop weekly can save more than £1000 per year!


