Remaining programme

- Jan 24 to Feb 24 – Main tree planting and other landscaping
- Feb 24 – reopen riverside footpath through Fisherton Rec and Ashley Road
- Mar 24 – Main works complete in Fisherton Rec and Ashley Road Open Space (seeding to happen in April)
- Feb 24 – Pedestrian route open through CCP and riverside path from Waitrose reopened
- Mar 24 – completion of vehicle bridge and highway works in CCP
- Mar 24 – Main works complete in CCP
- Apr 24 – Coach park works complete in CCP
- May 24 – All works complete and all areas reopened
