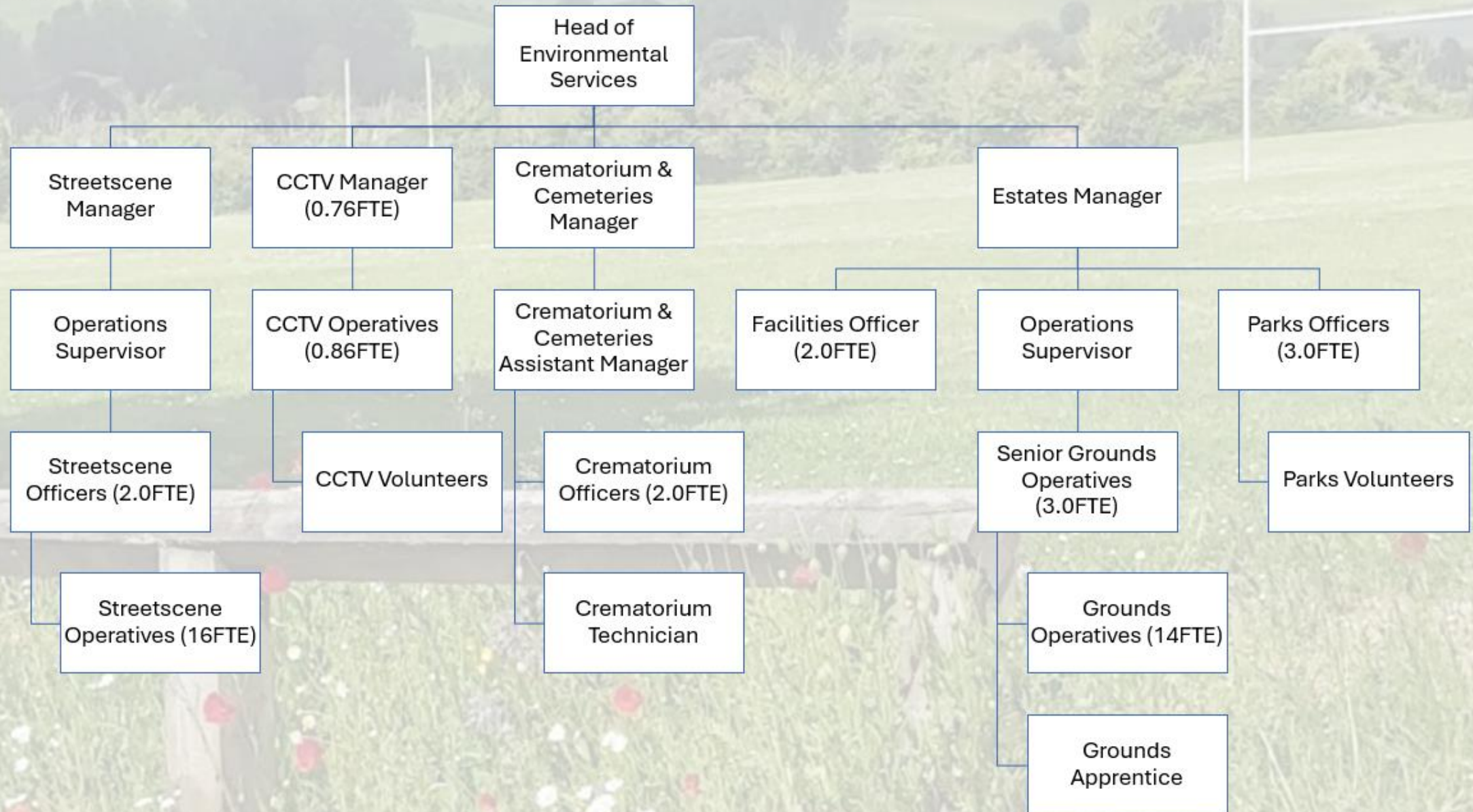

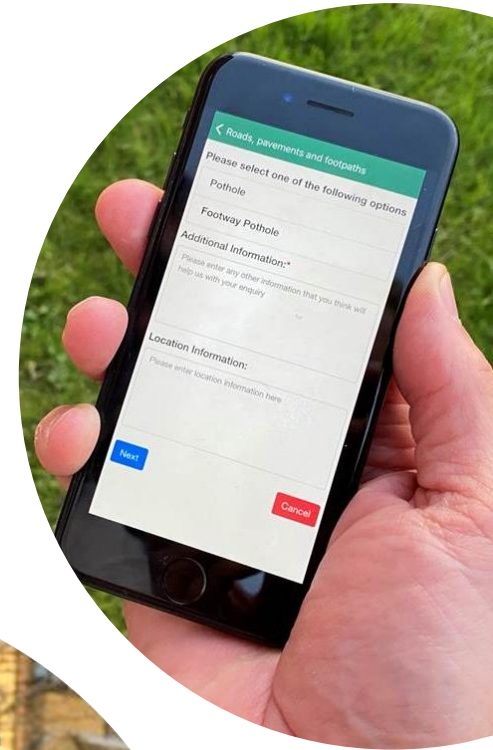

# Environmental Services Streetscene

- 10 new recycling bins on order to add to our growing number across the city.
- Stats for new financial year looking positive and team working hard to keep bins emptied and streets litter free.
- Currently recruiting for 2 Streetscene Operatives & a Streetscene Supervisor.
- Tom Simpkins has returned to Streetscene Officer post.



# Environmental Services Streetscene

Non-glyphosate weed spray ineffective. Team continue to hand weed and have ordered a weed ripper attachment for one of the sweepers.

Also ordered a strimmer and attachment (to eliminate flying debris).

Important to note that neither of these additions will remove roots of the weeds.



# Environmental Services Estates

- 47 Blue Boar Row sold – Capital Receipt of £338,474.00.
- Camping & Caravan Club – Phase 2 washroom facilities upgrade completed.
- New path being created at Pinewood Way as part of SCC's commitment to make our parks accessible to all.
- Pocket Park & Sustainable Planting Installed.
- Coldharbour Lane Improvements.



# Environmental Services Estates

- Currently working through fire risk assessment actions for Shop Mobility & The Friary Community Centre.
- Pothole repairs completed in Churchill Gardens Car Park.
- New Facilities Officer & Parks Officer appointed and due to start soon.
- Surface repaired around the Titan swing in Lizzy Gardens and swing now back in use.
- Newly planted trees all establishing well across the city.



# Environmental Services CCTV

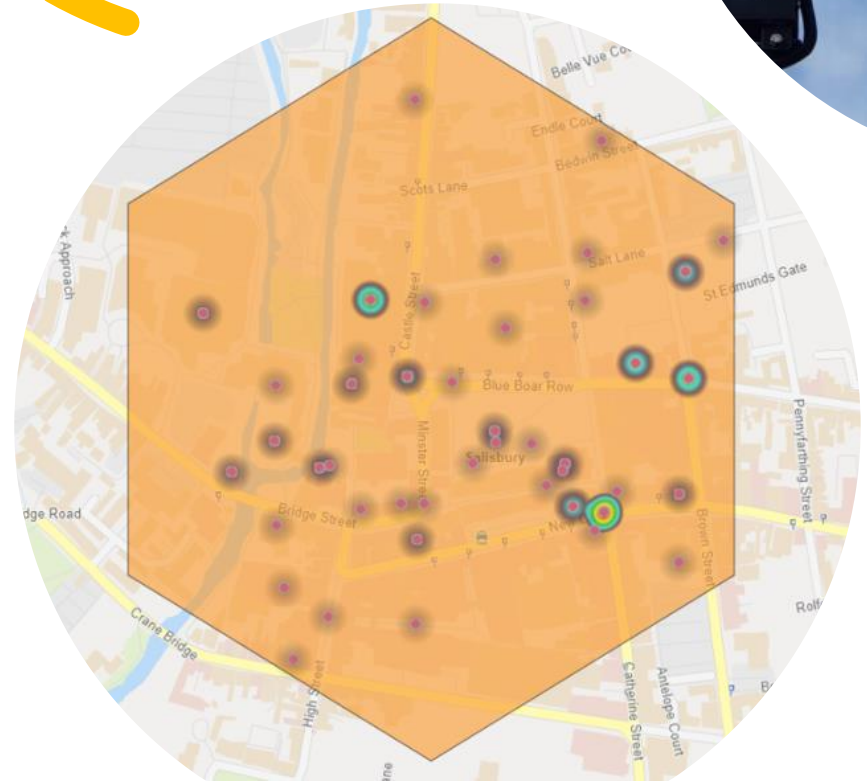
- The CCTV control room continues to have excellent coverage. However, new volunteers are needed and a recruitment campaign will happen later this year.
- CCTV Control Room Upgrade Completed. Training to staff and volunteers being provided.
- Upgrade to Guildhall CCTV complete.
- Bemerton Heath CCTV maintenance brought under our main contract and will also feed into the CCTV control room along with the Tollgate Road Depot and Guildhall.
- Awaiting a quote for CCTV upgrade to the Crematorium. The CCTV control room will not have a feed from the chapel for sensitivity reasons.



# Environmental Services CCTV

- Safer Streets Funding - 4 new deployable cameras installed.
- £95,000 OPCC Grant Funding Awarded to SCC to provide Hotspot Wardens in the City from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2024 – 31<sup>st</sup> March 2025. Contract to be managed by CCTV Manager, Keith Jackson.
- Not a like for like replacement of the previous City Council contract, as the hours are mainly focused for evenings.
- Numerous thanks from partners for the contribution that the CCTV control room have made to the safety of the city.

# Environmental Services Crematorium & Cemeteries

- The cremation figures from April 2024 – June 2024 total 313, compared to 301 across the same period in 2023/24.
- Crematorium LED lighting upgrade completed
- The Crematorium & Grounds continues to receive excellent feedback from funeral directors and mourners, as do the team.
- Proposal to have the flat roof replaced due to severe leakages given to Full Council. If approved the Crematorium would be closed to the public in August & September and services held at the Guildhall.
