The speed limit on the London Road from St Thomas Bridge to the Allotment Railway Bridge is 40 mph. This road is crossed hundreds of times a day by children taking the Golden Way route to and from the Laverstock Schools. There have already been incidents involving children being injured and RTCs at the Aldi turn off all with speed as a contributory factor. Why this road should still be 40 mph after all the development along it is a mystery. Some vehicles and motor bikes leaving Salisbury reach the 40 mph by the bridge and accelerate way past 40mph, the same happen after vehicles have been held at the Traffic Lights at the Barrington Road Junction, which is where the injury to a child occurred. Action to reduce the speed limit to 30mph is urgently needed before a very serious incident occurs due to speed.
