Nature of Issue: Inadequate signage and road markings at mini roundabout

Following collisions in successive weekends at this location in November 2024, frequent reports of 'near misses' in recent years, and following consultation with a significant number of local residents, it is evident that improved signage and clearer road markings are likely to reduce the risk of further collisions caused by southbound vehicles not giving way to northbound vehicles turning right into St. Francis Road.

The central raised island was recently repaired but not repainted and not a clearly visible as it should be for safety reasons.

This junction has gradually experienced an increased volume of traffic in recent years in part caused by construction of additional housing to the residential area accessed by turning right into St. Francis Road from Castle Road.

How long has it been an issue? Several years (according to many local residents)

What would you like done to resolve this issue?

- 'Keep left' bollard installed on existing empty 'traffic island' facing southbound access to roundabout.
- Additional mini roundabout signage installed on existing empty 'traffic island' on northbound side of carriageway (Castle Road) - facing southbound access to roundabout.
- **Give Way warning triangles** installed on left side of road and above **both** miniroundabout signs
