Issue Details

Location of Issue:	Fowler's Hill between Fowler's Road and Shady Bower
Community Area:	Salisbury
Parish or Town Council:	Salisbury City Council
Nature of Issue:	
Fowler's Hill is one way (traffic flow up hill). This is a problem for cyclists and makes accessing the underpass under the ring road to get to the quieter streets for access into town very difficult. Currently there is a break in the Salisbury Cycling Network from Laverstock into town. This could link Laverstock to the City Centre easily. The alternative route is Milford Hill -> Tollgate Road, which is busy and dangerous.	
How long has it been an issue?	Unknown
What would you like done to resolve this issue?	
I'd suggest a cycling contraflow (no cycle lane) with signage at the top by Shady Bower allowing access for cyclists down the hill, and a warning to motorists who are coming up the hill. For safety, the speed limit could also be reduced to 20mph as it's by a school.
