Dangerous crossing, no provision for safe crossing of this junction. There's no longer a crossing for pedestrians at Laverstock Road to get to "The Avenue" opposite.

The crossing was <u>very</u> dangerous anyway as pedestrians had to go half way across before they could see cars exiting Godolphin School / Laverstock Road traffic. No pavement to get into a position to see clearly as Godolphin School projects into the area.

Until recently we made a short cut through Godolphin School. It takes less than a minute! We have been told Pedestrians not permitted! It is very dangerous. One elderly man was turned back.

How long has it been an issue? Some months

What would you like done to resolve this issue?

A <u>safe</u> way of crossing. A consideration by Godolphin School to allow pedestrians to access the safe option. We have used it, causing no difficulty for many years. There has been a recent change in governance there. It is the school's protruding wall that causes this unavoidable dangerous situation.
