Nature of Issue:

Uneven and poorly illuminated cycle/pedestrian route and hazardous pavement

The walking / cycle route running parallel to Shelley Drive alongside the allotments behind the houses, recently re-surfaced is extremely uneven and floods regularly after heavy rainfall. Although the route, which runs from the Five Rivers Leisure Centre has street lighting which end near the entrance to the allotments does not extend to the end of the route at Stratford Road near Castle Keep. This is causing accessibility and safety issues for cyclists and pedestrians.

The pavement from Castle Keep to Mill Lane along Stratford Road is extremely dangerous in several places presenting significant tripping hazards particularly for elderly residents but also making the access to Stratford sub Castle School for parents pushing buggies and children difficult.

How long has it been an issue?

At least four years to my knowledge.

What would you like done to resolve this issue?

1. Walking / cycle route to be restored to an even and level to ensure safety for users and reduce levels of flooding. (Behind houses in Shelley Drive.)

2. Install adequate street lighting on walking / cycle route. (Behind houses in Shelley Drive.)



Completely re-surface pavements on both sides of Stratford Road between Castle Keep and Mill Lane. (See attached images below of examples pavements along route – there are many more!)
