Cllr Hocking introduced the item and local residents spoke in support. Increasing numbers of Commercial (eg HGVs, vans, articulated vehicles, etc), Public Service (eg buses and coaches) and private vehicles (eg cars and caravans) are increasingly using this narrow cul-de-sac road, at all times of day and night. The current road narrows, vehicles get stuck at various points and have to reverse and/or try and turn around, particularly between Swan Close and Britford Lane West.

It appears that SatNavs are sending drivers down this no-through-road route. Clearer road markings and signage required (currently there are none). It was,
