A recent review of the Safeguarding Children and Vulnerable Adults policy identified recommendations that safeguarding regarding children and adults should managed with separate policies due to differing situations in that adults may or may not be able to provide informed consent for abusive situations to be reported
- 2.2. The revised policies set out clear procedures for staff, volunteers and councillors to follow

 - 3.1.1. Safeguarding Children Policy
 - 3.1.2. Adults at Risk Policy
- 3.2. The Term 'adult at risk' is used in this policy to replace 'vulnerable adult', as recommend on Gov.uk/safeguarding adult. This is because the term 'vulnerable adult' may wrongly imply that some of the fault for the abuse lies with the victim of abuse.
