1. Report Summary

- 1.1. This report asks for the committee to consider new applications from local organisations to become a Salisbury City Lottery Good Cause within the Salisbury City Council run Salisbury City Council Community Lottery..

2. Background

- 2.1. Salisbury City Community Lottery is a weekly lottery that raises money for good causes in the Salisbury City area. All good causes supported by the lottery will benefit the Salisbury City area and its residents. Details can be seen here <https://www.salisburycommunitylottery.co.uk/>
- 2.2. Salisbury City Community Lottery Good Causes must be operating or delivering a service within the City Boundary and for the demonstrable benefit of Salisbury City Residents
- 2.3. Eligible groups are Associations, Charities, Clubs, CIC's, Social Enterprises, Constituted Community Groups & Societies
- 2.4. Eligible good causes must have a bank account and two signatories.

3. Applications:

3.1.1. **Old Sarum and Long Hedge Community Centre**

- 3.1.1.1. This organisation is a registered charity and community asset, providing community space for a number of projects of significant community impact, including the Old Sarum and Long Hedge Pantry.
- 3.1.1.2. This cause, however, operates outside the geographical boundary of Salisbury City and provides a service direct to the community of the surrounding estates. Their application does state that they provide their services across a reach of "15 miles around SP4 6GH". However, there is a strong case to say that this cause does not, therefore, meet the eligibility criteria for the Salisbury City Community Lottery Good Causes.

3.1.1.3. **Spire Inclusion Day Provision for Adults with Autism**

- 3.1.1.4. This service is newly located at the Community Centre of St Micheal's Church in Bemerton heath. Their aims are to "Push Boundaries and unleash potential" by providing meaningful activities and care.
- 3.1.1.5. The company is a CIC and meets all the eligibility criteria for the Salisbury City Community Lottery Good Causes
- 3.1.1.6. This cause has provided all the required documentation and meets all Salisbury City Community Lottery

4. Recommendation:

It is recommended that:

4.1. The Sub Committee:

- 4.1.1. Rejects the application from **Old Sarum and Long Hedge Community Centre** on the basis that it does not meet the eligibility criteria on the basis of geographical location, outside of the Salisbury City Ward boundaries.
- 4.1.2. Approve the application from **Spire Inclusion Day Provision for Adults with Autism.**
