## Issue Details

<b>Location of Issue:</b>	Feversham Rd/Radnor Rd/Beatrice Rd

<b>Nature of Issue:</b>		
<p>Car parking on both sides of the roads listed in the location hidding other road users and in particular the R4 bus route. Cars are often parked on the corners of these streets, causing the R4 bus to divert from its planned route and hence missing a bus stop in Feversham road. Why can't the cars, if owned by the residents of these streets, use the driveways of the houses? Why aren't there double yellow lines along one side of these streets, for example in Waters Road Salisbury, where resident cars are only allowed to park on one side of the road. Your feedback please.</p>		
<b>How long has it been an issue?</b>	Over 6 years	
<b>What would you like done to resolve this issue?</b>		
<p>Paint double yellow lines along one side of the following roads - Faversham/Radnor and Beatrice. send out a letter informing the residents of the painting of the yellow lines and hence the parking restriction so as to allow buses and cars easier passage along these roads. Cars found to be parked on yellow lines should be fined. Residents should also be made aware of the Highway Code that clearly states that parking a car on a corner near a junction hinders traffic flow, as well as causing problems for other vehicles, such as buses.</p>
