There are no parking restrictions at this junction, which means that people park their cars illegally on the junctions. This makes it very difficult for residents, who report that visibility is restricted in both directions making it very hard for them to pull out of Shakespeare Road onto Stratford Road and their safety, and the safety of other road users is compromised.

The problem is exacerbated particularly at weekends, when football and rugby is being played on Hudson's field. One older resident explained that she and her husband no longer go out in their car on Sunday mornings as they have had some very 'close calls' and do not feel safe to do so.
