


# Highways Improvement Request Form

## Issue Details

<b>Location of Issue:</b>	<p>Junction where Millbrook joins the Laverstock Road in Salisbury</p>  <p>(Please add a location plan where possible)</p>
<b>Community Area:</b>	Salisbury
<b>Parish or Town Council:</b>	Salisbury City Council
<p><b>Nature of Issue:</b> The junction of Millbrook onto Laverstock Road has limited visibility for drivers on Millbrook wanting to join Laverstock Road, and drivers on Laverstock Road who do not see the Millbrook junction well either. To join Laverstock Road from Millbrook you need to edge out to see whether traffic is coming and check it is safe to turn out, and traffic on Laverstock Road is often coming at enough speed to make this potentially dangerous. This junction is used by residents of Millbrook and staff, students and parents of the Godolphin School. This route is also very busy at rush hour/school run time and is a narrow part of the road which adds to problems exiting Millbrook.</p>	

<b>How long has it been an issue?</b>	For more than 20 years.
<b>What would you like done to resolve this issue?</b> (max 600 characters)	
Please could the following measures to improve road safety at this junction be implemented: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Install 'Concealed Entrance' signs on the Laverstock Road from both direction warning drivers of the Millbrook junction and encouraging them to slow down.</li> <li>2. Please can a visibility mirror be installed opposite Millbrook to aid visibility for drivers wanting to exit Millbrook and join the Laverstock Road.</li> <li>3. Can a 20 MPH limit be imposed from the roundabout at the bottom of Laverstock Road (where it meets Bourne Ave).</li> </ol>
