Issue Details

Location of Issue:	Upper, Middle, Lower Streets and all the roads in between, in Harnham
Community Area:	Salisbury
Parish or Town Council:	Harnham
Nature of Issue:	
Lower and Middle Streets are heavily used by pedestrians using the foot and cycle path 'Town Path' to access the city. This includes mobility scooters, children in prams or walking to school and dog walkers. There are no footpaths in a number of places forcing pedestrians to use the road as they exit the Town Path and there are multiple blind and sharp corners for car drivers to navigate on the entire stretch of road. Middle St meadow is used by numerous children and some exits are directly onto the road. It is a matter of time before there is a serious accident on this stretch of road.	
How long has it been an issue?	Since we've lived here (Dec 2021)
What would you like done to resolve this issue?	
The speed limit for this stretch of road needs to be reduced to 20mph. You cannot drive safely above 20mph (15mph on blind corners) on Middle and Lower St as pedestrians have no choice but to walk in the road in many places due to the lack of footpaths.	
There is a very high risk of an accident occurring as the speed at which the cars drive vs the number of pedestrians using the road make this a hazardous area. Safety of pedestrians is the primary concern here.
