1. **Report Summary:**

- 1.1 There have been no applications from community groups to become new community lottery good causes over the last quarter.
- 1.2 Further work is needed to promote this opportunity to additional eligible community groups to support their work in our communities.

- 2.1 Salisbury City Community Lottery is a weekly lottery that raises money for good causes in the Salisbury City area. All good causes supported by the Lottery will benefit the Salisbury City area and its residents. Details can be found here: <https://www.salisburycommunitylottery.co.uk>
- 2.2 Salisbury City Community Lottery Good Causes must be operating or delivering a service within the City Boundary and for the demonstrable benefit of Salisbury City Residents.
- 2.3 Eligible groups are Associations, Charities, Clubs, CIC's, Social Enterprises, Constituted Community Groups and Societies.
- 2.4 Eligible good causes must have a bank account and two signatories.
- 2.5 The lottery currently has 58 live causes.

- 3.1 There are no current applications for review.

4. **Annual reporting headline data**

- 4.1 There have been 755 tickets sold in the last year.
- 4.2 Total annual funds generated for the 58 approved good causes in 2025 from Salisbury Community Lottery is £23,556.00.

- 5.1 That committee supports the recommendation that the Communities team undertake promotional work with community networks and on social media to encourage more eligible groups to apply to become a lottery good cause.
