

## Highways Improvement Request Form

### Issue Details

<b>Location of Issue:</b>	Roundabout near Parkwood Gym, Salisbury, at the point where the road splits into two lanes heading toward the city centre (crossing point used by pedestrians between Parkwood Gym side and Bishopdown)
<b>Community Area:</b>	Salisbury
<b>Parish or Town Council:</b>	Salisbury
<b>Nature of Issue:</b>	
<p>The roundabout near Parkwood Gym in Salisbury is extremely dangerous for pedestrians crossing toward Bishopdown. During peak hours (7–9 AM and 3:30–6 PM), vehicles on the inner lane often fail to stop while outer-lane drivers yield, causing confusion and near misses. I've nearly been hit twice, most recently yesterday when a car came within 5 metres of me. Many other pedestrians also struggle to cross safely.</p>	
<b>How long has it been an issue?</b>	The situation has been dangerous for <b>over a year(from when I moved into the area)</b> , worsening as traffic has increased.
<b>What would you like done to resolve this issue?</b>	
<p>I request an urgent site assessment for pedestrian safety improvements — ideally a <b>zebra or light-controlled crossing</b>.. These measures would greatly improve safety for pedestrians, especially during peak traffic hours.</p>
