



Notice of Motion - NM63

Disabled residents of the city have expressed concern that accessing the new River Park entrance on Coldharbour Lane cannot be achieved without routing along 70m of the Council owned roadway which is considered potentially hazardous. This Council believes that a paved footpath, suitable for use by those with disabilities and mobility issues, should be laid alongside Dennis Marsh House connecting the pavement of Kingsland Road to a drop kerb opposite the entrance to the River Park (to the rear of 9 Westminster Road).

At the last Full Council Meeting (15 September) the resolution was that: The Council supports in principle the provision of a new footpath along Coldharbour Lane and instructs officers to obtain detailed costings and bring a report back to Full Council for decision on funding.

A detailed quote has been obtained from the Council's D & N Maintenance Ltd for £32,966.03.

Resolution:

This Council approves the funding of the project with monies from the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) funds. Should insufficient funds be made available from CIL Funds the project will be included in the budget for 2026/2027.

I urge all Councillors to support this motion in the interest of the residents of our city particularly the disabled and those with mobility issues.
