CHANGING LIVES EVERY DAY



- Fitted with lifesaving equipment.
- One defibrillator deployed by Northern Ireland Ambulance Service each month across Belfast.
- No. 1 intervention to increase the likelihood of survival in an Out of Hospital Cardiac Arrest.

- Cardiac arrest survival rates are 70% if a defibrillator is used within five minutes.
- Survival chances for victims decrease by 10% for every minute without a defibrillator (AED) being used.



Saving lives

- Working with Health and Social Care Northern Ireland and drug outreach organisations to develop a protocol to deploy nasal naloxone in the case of opiate overdose.
- The nasal spray is a treatment designed to rapidly reverse the effects of drugs like heroin, morphine, methadone and fentanyl.
- We are also in discussions over the provision of bleeding control kits in the pulsehubs.
- These are specialised trauma kits designed to provide bystanders with the products they need to stop life-threatening bleeding until paramedics arrive.

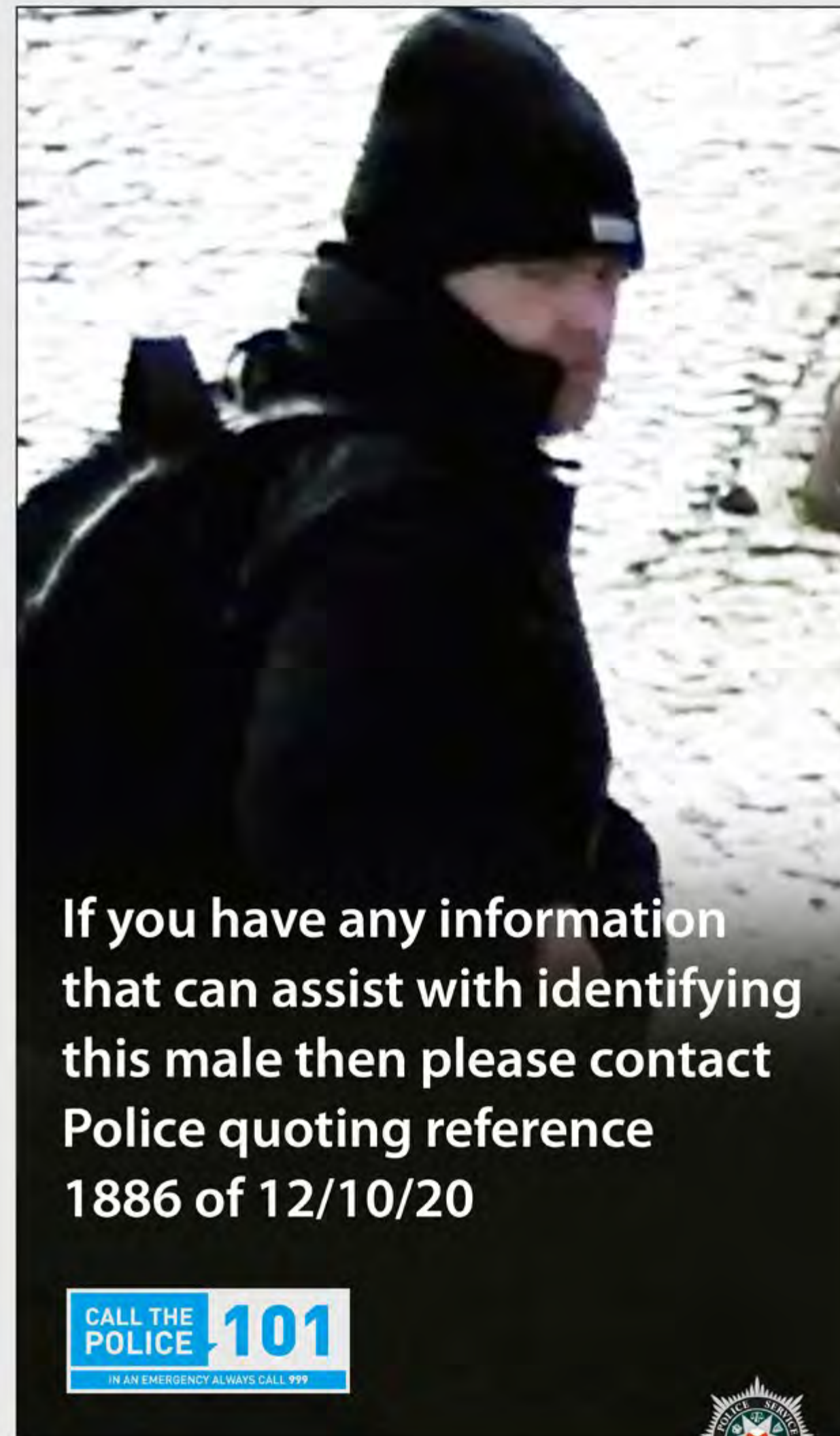

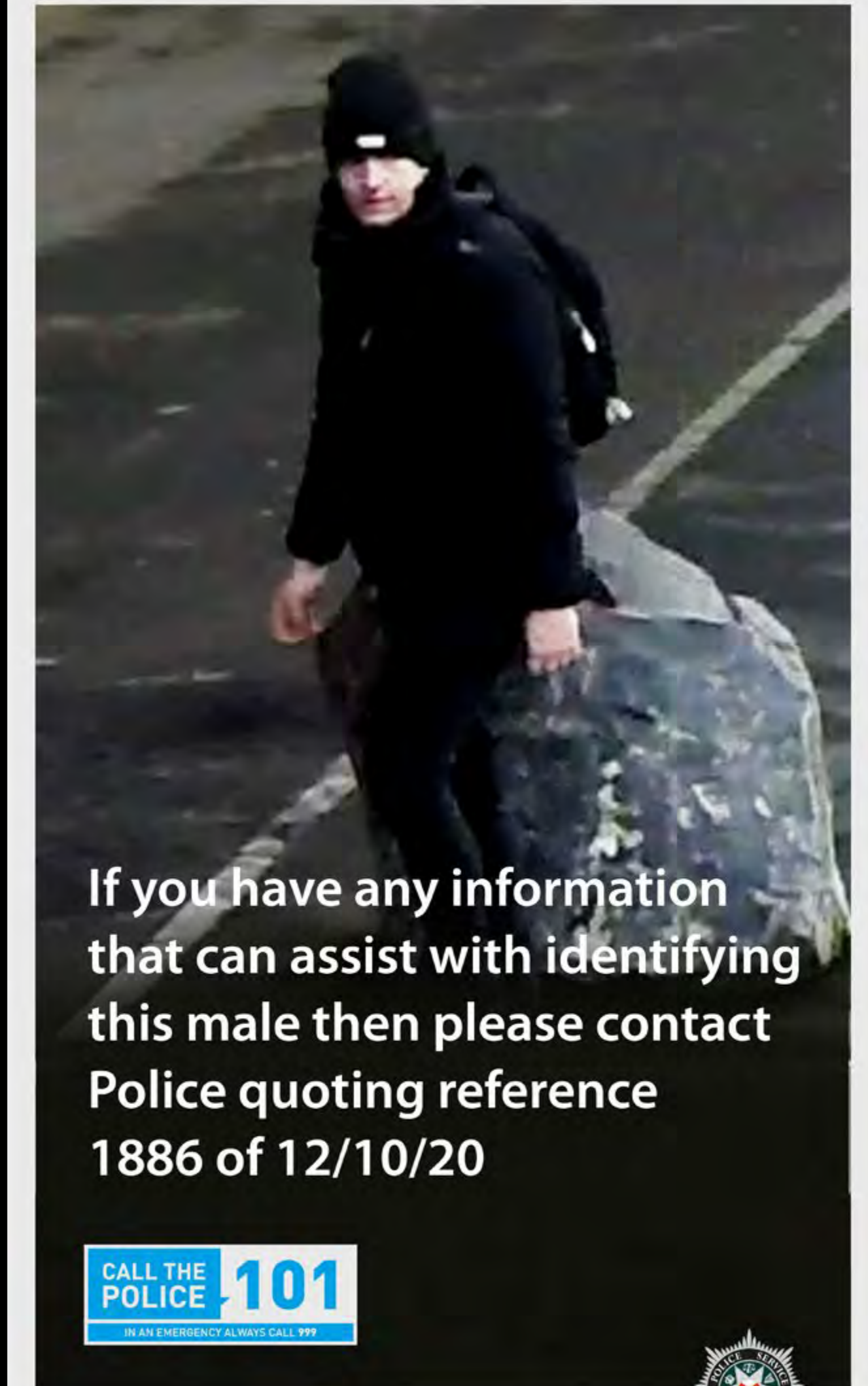


Ability to override the content across all the screens in the event of serious situations that requiring an emergency response and to notify the public.

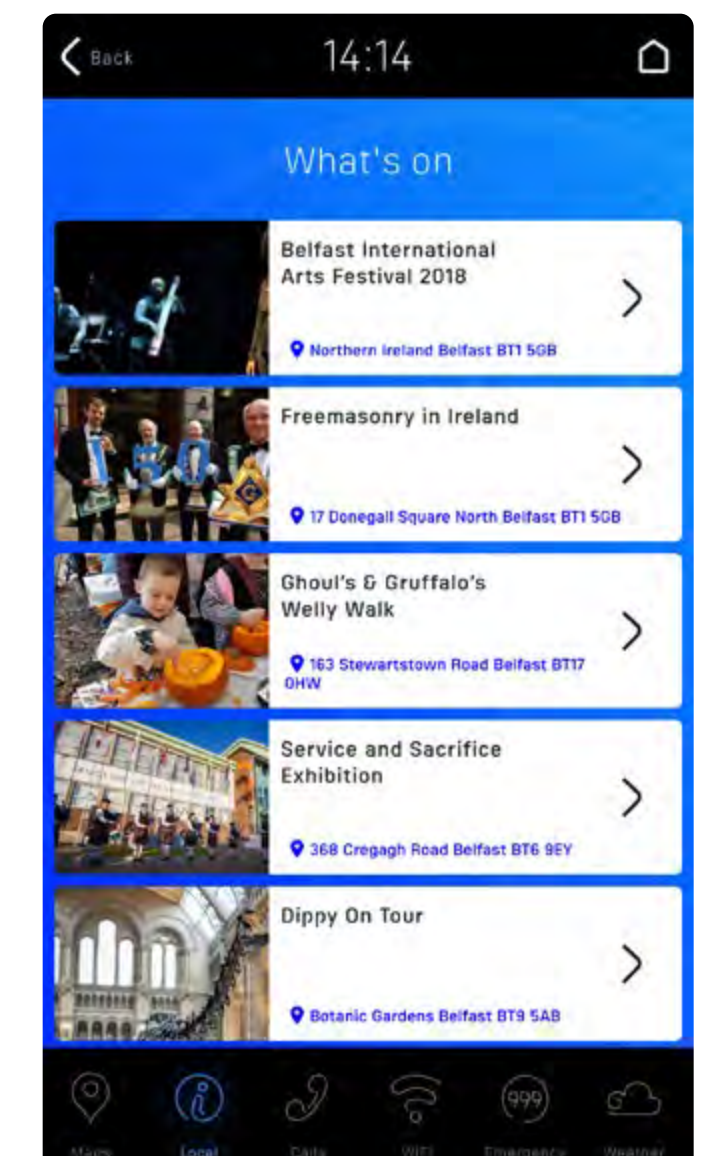
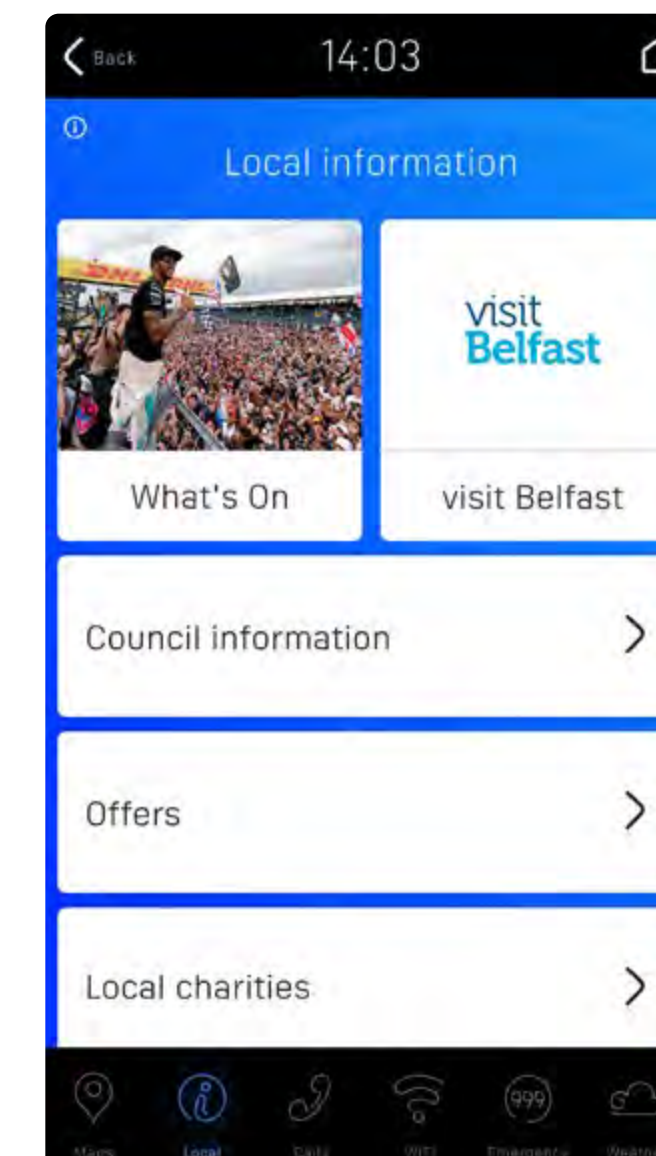
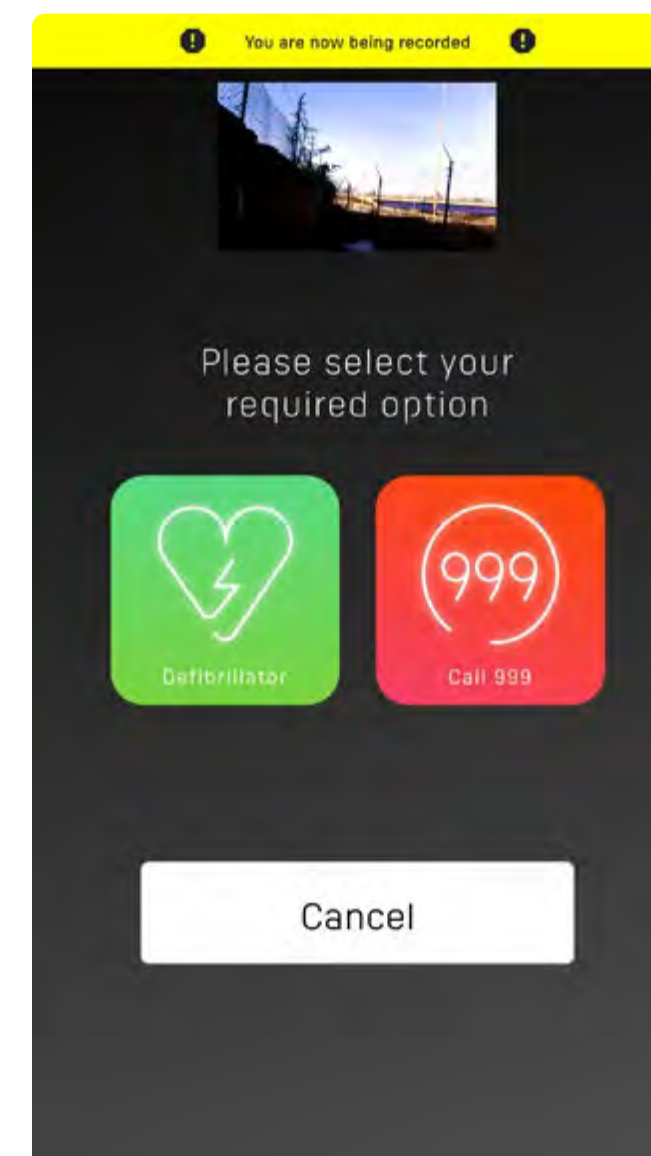
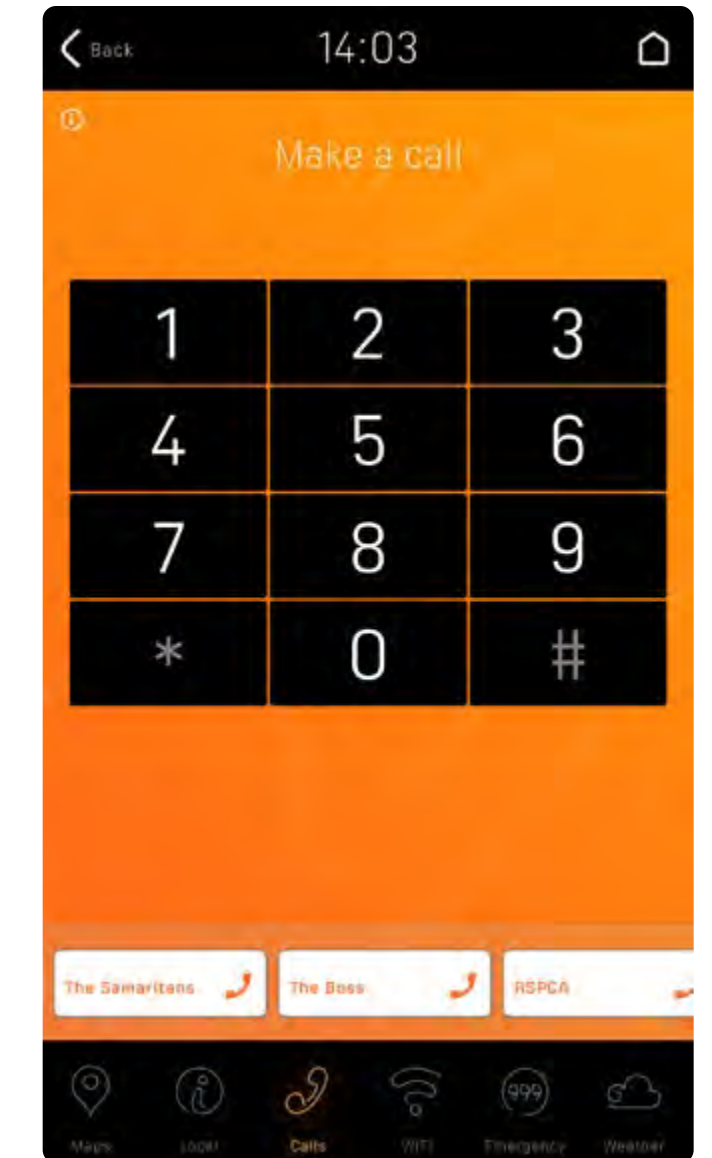
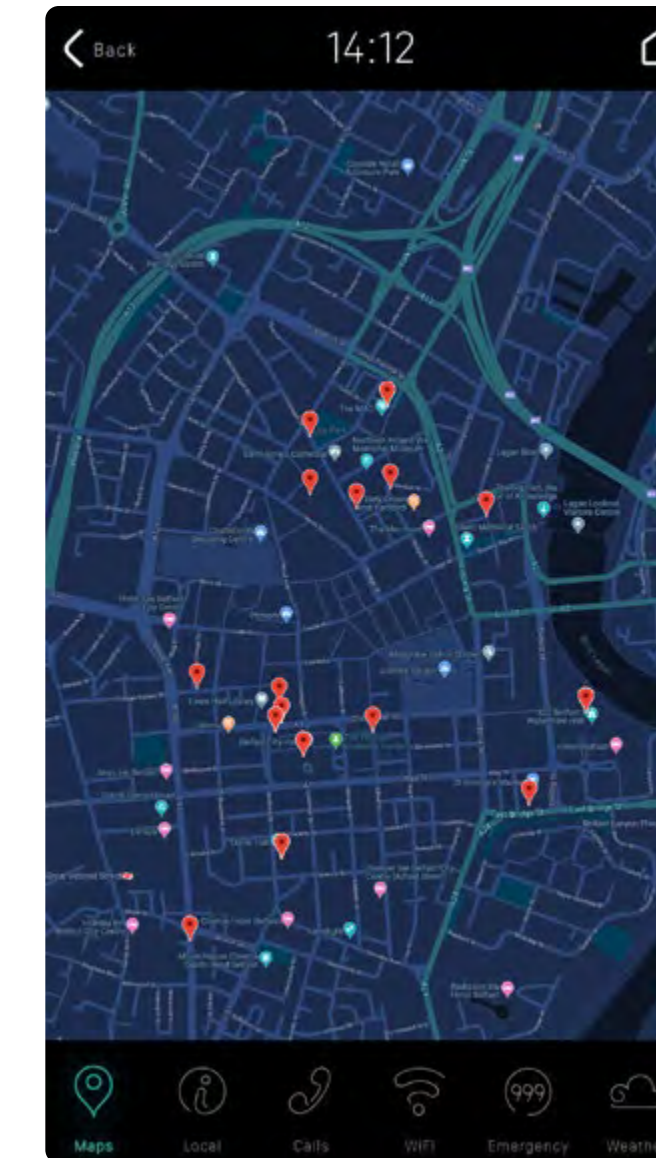
- Provides power, data and space for city centre technology to enable a better understanding of our cities e.g. collecting and sharing data on air quality, pedestrian footfall and traffic flow.
- Environmental Sensors collecting Nitric Oxide, Nitrogen Dioxide and Carbon Monoxide data are being collected in Belfast.

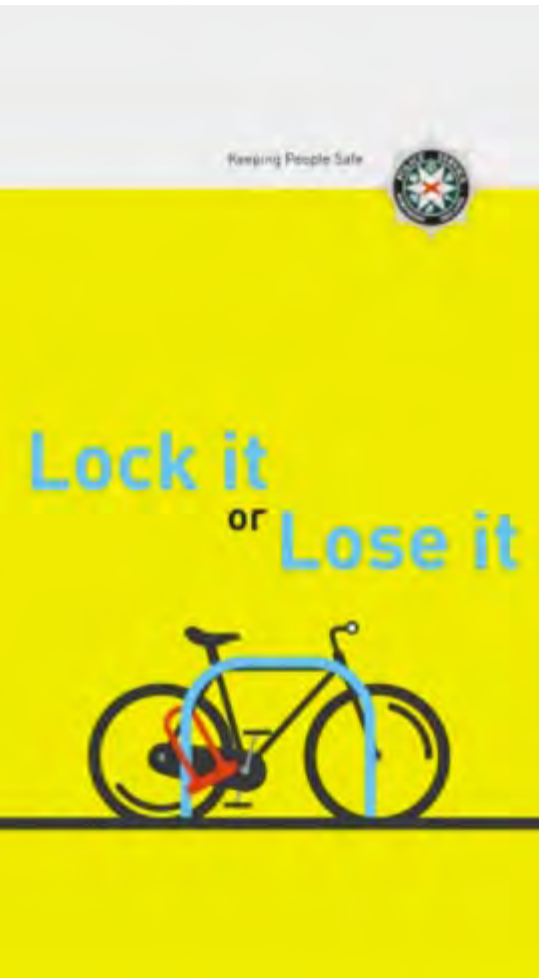
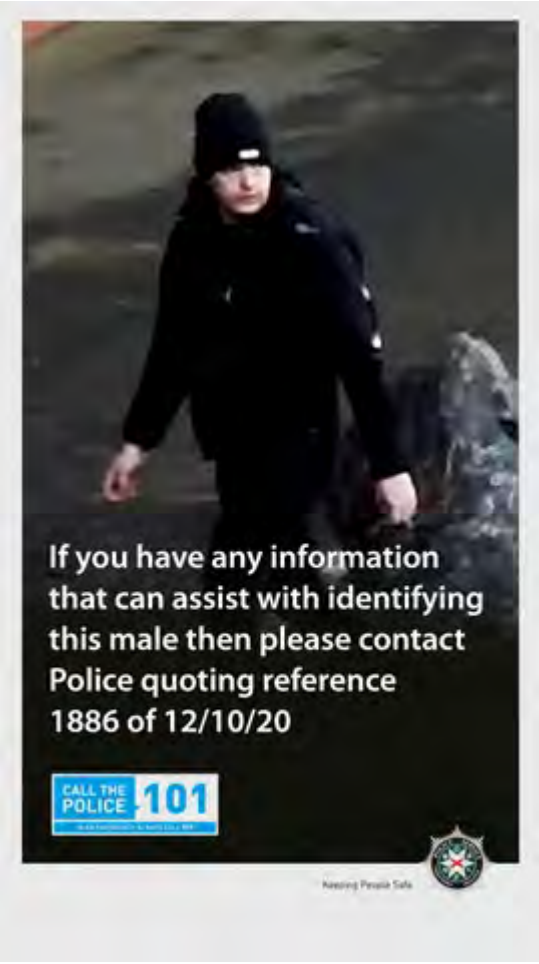
Public messaging

A **5% minimum** of all display time guaranteed **free of charge** for local stakeholders.

This equates to 650 free messaging slots per Hub, per day. This provides a valuable channel to reach residents, workers, visitors and tourists with important public messaging and campaigns.
