Subject : Use of WW1 Memorial Names for Future Street Naming

1. Report Summary:

1.1 This report presents a proposal from a member of the public suggesting that Salisbury City Council consider using names of local World War I servicemen for future street naming.

1.2 Officers have collated a verified list of names from the memorial panels and commemorative book held at St Thomas's Church. The intention is to provide a historically meaningful and respectful reference list that may be used in future development naming proposals across the parish.

2. Background:

2.1 A member of the public contacted the Council with a request to honour Salisbury's World War I servicemen by considering their names for new streets and developments within the city.

2.2 In response, officers have compiled a list of names from the WW1 memorial and Book of Remembrance at St Thomas's Church. This list includes forename, surname, rank, and date of death where available. The list is now submitted to the Committee for consideration and potential endorsement as a reference tool.

3. Recommended changes

3.1 Officers recommend that the list be noted and held by the Council as a non-binding, advisory resource for use in consultation with developers and Wiltshire Council when considering future street naming.

3.2 It is proposed that any specific naming proposals derived from this list continue to be brought forward on a case-by-case basis, in accordance with the established street naming policy and in liaison with the relevant planning authority.

3.3 The following principles are proposed for using the list:

3.3.1 Use of names should be context-sensitive, ensuring no duplication or confusion with existing Salisbury or Wiltshire Street names.

3.3.2 Community engagement should be considered where naming opportunities are significant or high-profile.

3.4 The full list will be stored and maintained by the Corporate Services team and may be updated in future with additional research or commemorative entries as appropriate.

4. Recommendation:

4.1 It is recommended that the Committee:

4.1.1 Notes the public request and the officer response in compiling the WW1 memorial name list.

4.1.2 Decide that the list be retained as an optional reference for future street naming discussions and proposals.

4.1.3 Confirms that any individual naming proposals will continue to follow the established procedures and be submitted for approval in the usual way.
