

BEMERTON HEATH JUMP TRACK

HOW TO RIDE THE JUMP TRACK

The Jump Track is a progression from the pump track and features large **unavoidable** and **unrollable** jumps.

There are two jump lines: the left hand side with asphalt take-offs is smaller and should be ridden first. The right hand line with wooden take-offs is a progression from the left. Once you are comfortable clearing all the jumps on the left line you can progress to the right.

The jumps on both lines slightly increase in size along the length of the line and culminate in a step-up jump at the end.



CODE OF CONDUCT

- LOOK BEFORE YOU LEAP!
- Riders ahead and on track have right of way
- Ensure your bike is in good working order
- Helmets and appropriate protective clothing should be worn when using this track
- Ride within your ability and keep your bike under control
- Please keep to the track
- No littering
- No motorised bikes or vehicles
