<u>Extract from email from Alison Holloway (local resident) received 11.05.26</u> I wondered if we could pick this issue up again about the pedestrian crossings opposite Hudsons Field? Of recent concern was a fellow dog walker informing me of some sad news about another owners dog getting run over at the crossing point opposite Hudsons Field, whilst the owner was stuck in the central refuge trying to cross between vehicles. This sounded just awful. The outbound A345 carriageway at this point narrows - a lorry far exceeds the white lines making it extremely dangerous and those coming into and out of Salisbury often don't even acknowledge you trying to cross from this central point. It has become so busy at the peak times now and these crossing points become inadequate I feel, and dangerous places to wait to get across between lanes, especially so with dogs or a pushchair. Its not so bad further down because the road is far wider.	
How long has it been an issue?	Ongoing for some time!
What would you like done to resolve this issue?	
I am requesting a review of the location of the crossing refuge on Castle Road adjacent to access point to Hudson's Field. Note – I have recently received several complaints from residents regarding speeding traffic at this location and there was also another LHFIF request regarding an adjustment to the bus lane markings following a serious collision at the junction of St Paul's Dene and Castle Road. I am not sure speed monitoring in the past has revealed any evidence of the need for additional measures to be considered.
