Issue Details

Location of Issue:	Layby along London Road - northbound – between bus-stop and railway bridge.
Community Area:	Salisbury
Parish or Town Council:	Salisbury City Council
Nature of Issue:	
The parking bay that runs along London Rd - between the church and the railway bridge - used to have clear white lines – denoting where vehicles could park to avoid blocking access to houses that are adjacent. We have lived at our address for over 35 years and in that time, all markings have worn away. In recent years/months, with more vehicles parking along the road, driveways to our property, (and others along the road) occasionally become partly blocked by parked vehicles – as there are no lines defining where to park. As a result, it can be dangerous to both residents and other road users when we try to leave our driveway by car (as visibility is restricted). I'm attaching a photo taken recently which (hopefully) illustrates the issue.	



How long has it been an issue?

Ongoing over several years – but worse recently

What would you like done to resolve this issue?

We would simply like to request that some markings – especially those which show driveways need to be kept clear – are reinstated. This would improve driver safety for both residents and road users along London Road.
