Issue Details

Location of Issue:	Bottom of Old Blandford Road where it meets Harnham Road
Community Area:	Salisbury
Parish or Town Council:	Salisbury City Council
Nature of Issue:	
This concerns permitted parking which is dangerous and could potentially cause an accident. The location is at the very bottom of the Old Blandford Road, where it joins Harnham Road. There is a marked parking lane at the bottom of the road, on the left hand side as you face up the hill. The parking of vehicles here means that if traffic is coming down the hill, vehicles turning into the Old Blandford Road from Harnham Road must wait and thus potentially cause an obstruction to traffic on the main road. In addition, drivers of vehicles exiting Chiselbury Grove have no view at all of whether any vehicles are coming up or down the hill so are in danger of pulling out in the path of an oncoming vehicle. There is plenty of safe parking in permitted areas just a little further up the hill.	
How long has it been an issue?	As long as I've lived here (since October 2024) – and since whenever the parking area was first introduced
What would you like done to resolve this issue?	
I would like to request that you look into this and make the very bottom of the hill a no parking zone.
