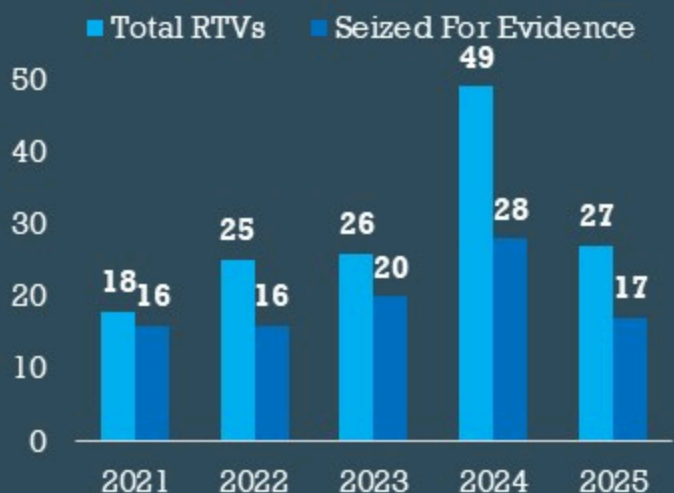
### HOURS WORKED IN OCTOBER

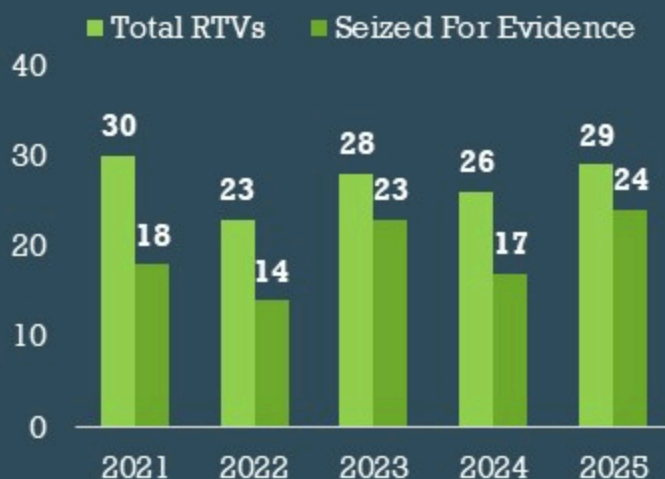
### HOURS WORKED IN NOVEMBER

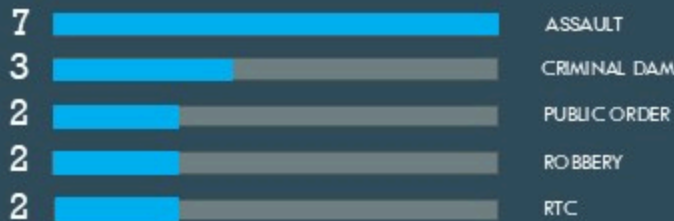

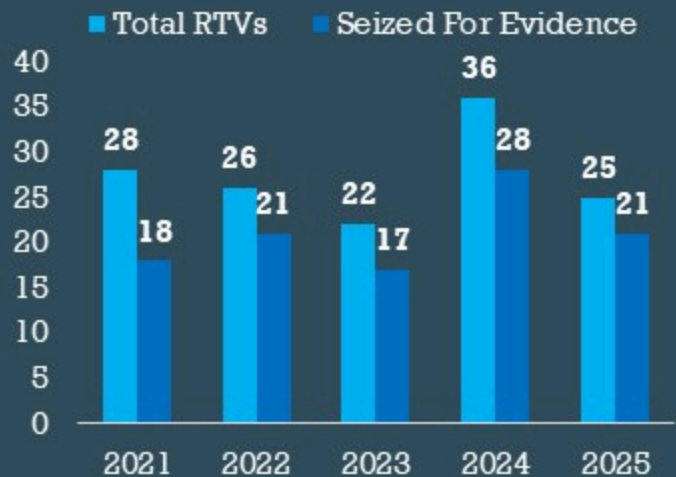
### HOURS WORKED IN DECEMBER
