Nature of Issue:		
I am Chair of the Milford Area Preservation Group. We curate part of Milford Hollow as a conservation site. This site has been the subject of fly-tipping. Vehicles have illegally accessed the area via the pedestrian path which leads from Shady Bower (opposite St Martin's school) to Milford Hollow. Removing tipped waste presents an enormous challenge to our volunteers. Huge damage has been caused to the plantings our Group has made. This is distressing and costly.

What would you like done to resolve this issue?		
We would like a bollard to be placed at the top of the path, where it meets Shady Bower. This bollard should be collapsable to allow the owners of Venn House (Mr and Mrs Garland) to access their garage which is the bottom of the path and adjacent to the conservation site. The Garlands are supportive of this measure. The bollard would prevent fly tippers driving into the Hollow
